Summary of Request

On behalf of Ascension Saint Thomas Midtown (ASTM) ("Owner") in Nashville, TN, Medxcel Facilities Management ("Medxcel") is seeking responses from qualified Ascension Health national construction partners for participation in Request for Proposals (RFP) from General Contractors to provide general contractor services for Ascension Saint Thomas Midtown Hospital Surge Resiliency Unit ("Project").

The overall strategy will be executed via Ascension's Integrated Project Delivery (IDP) agreement, where all the Architects, Engineers, Consultants, and Contractors participate in the IDP.

The terms of the RFP process and the steps and processes set forth herein are subject to change at the discretion of Medxcel and the Owner. Nothing herein, including the firm's response to or participation in the RFP process, shall be deemed or construed as a right to, or promise of, any contract award or business from or with Ascension Health and/or its Subsidiaries, Health Systems, and Hospitals. Once we receive the intent to respond to this RFP, firms will be held to all statements of capability, functionality, process, and timelines or through any other correspondence.

Proposals are hereby requested based on the identified expertise and experience necessary to achieve the Owner's strategic objective.

Firms must advise Medxcel of their intent to respond to this RFP. Once emailed intent is received, the drawings can be shared. Firms must email responses to David Campbell (David.Campbell@medxcel.com) within 14 days of posting.

The Project

The Project shall be delivered in alignment with the Ascension IPD Master Services Agreement (MSA). The MSA for General Contractor Services will be executed with the terms, conditions, and fee schedule as-is, with no negotiation. In addition to the MSA contract documents, the required contract documents will include ATTACHMENT FLOWDOWN TERMS, Required Federal Contract Provisions – March 7, 2024, Invoice Requirements, and Certification Regarding Debarment.

The general scope of the Project shall be based on certain key elements.

Statement of Purpose

This Scope of Work (SOW) aims to expand surge capacity for Ascension Saint Thomas Midtown, located in Nashville, Davidson County, Tennessee, funded through the Healthcare Resiliency Capital Investments program, as approved by the State of Tennessee Department of Health.

The Sub-Recipient, Ascension Saint Thomas Midtown, agrees to administer and complete the project per the scope of work submitted by the Sub-Recipient and approved by the State of Tennessee Department of Health. The Sub-Recipient shall complete the work per all applicable Federal, State, and Local Laws, Regulations, and Codes.

General Qualifications

Medxcel seeks to engage with a selected Partner and its key individuals to achieve the Project goals through participation in the pre-construction process, schedule management, cost management, and work execution.

Medxcel intends to onboard one General Contractor.

The selected General Contractor shall provide key team members a voice in driving the development and completion of the Project. The individuals shall be the primary, devoted personnel who will communicate and coordinate the services and efforts under the leadership of Medxcel.

We seek advice, expertise, construction documents and specifications, and construction administration services for the overall task intended to be defined collaboratively with professionals with the capacity and documented experience in assignments of this nature.

Project Overview

Under this Healthcare Resiliency Capital Investments program, the State of Tennessee has allocated funds that provide investments in the brick-and-mortar expansion and improvement of patient-care areas of adult Acute Care Hospitals. This will allow these critical facilities to continue to respond to the COVID-19 pandemic



and to be prepared for future health crises in Tennessee. These Terms and Conditions shall be effective from March 3, 2021 ("Effective date") to June 30, 2026.

The Surge Resiliency Unit Project consists of the refresh/renovation of three wings on the fourth floor of the ASTM Hospital campus. These areas consist of antiquated patient care areas that will be transformed into 14 Critical Care flex beds, three (3) Operating Suites, and six (6) step-down beds. In addition to the existing Intensive Care Units (ICU), Post-Acute Care Unit (PACU), Emergency Department (ED), and Medical/Surgical beds used as overflow beds during the recent pandemic surges, these three areas would offer an additional 20 flex beds dedicated to being a pandemic surge area with full isolation from other units. The Critical Care Unit would be created by renovating approximately 13,607 square feet of existing floor space, providing 14 additional private patient rooms. Renovation of approximately 6,250 square feet of existing floor space would create a step-down unit within the 4th floor that can be easily converted to handle surge capacity. This would provide up to six (6) additional private patient rooms (w/flex capability) with toilets and showers. Renovating another approximately 6,250 square feet of existing, vacant, antiquated Operating Room (OR) space would allow for three (3) isolated Operating Suites within the unit. All three (3) adjacent spaces would create a totally isolated Surge Resiliency Unit, essentially a "hospital within a hospital." The renovation of all three areas would include required Information Technology (IT) hardware and software, medical equipment, furnishings, non-medical equipment, and other required support infrastructure.

Executive Management Team

The Executive Management Team will comprise C-Level Executive(s), with binding signatory authority, from each party participating in the IPD Agreement. These individuals shall not be decision-makers of any other project's teams. The function of this team is to manage dispute resolution and support the Project Management Team. A senior leader from Ascension Saint Thomas Midtown will participate on this team.

Project Management Team

The core of the Project Management Team shall be composed of one representative each from the Owner, architect, engineer, and contractor. The core team may elect other key parties to participate in this decision-making team. Each shall be given one voice in the decision-making process for the delivery and execution of the project. Members of this core team shall not serve as members of the Executive Management Team. The Owner's role shall be to have one voice in the team even though the Owner may have many members in



consultation for the execution of the project. The Owner's voice will come from the Construction Project Manager assigned to the Project by Medxcel Planning, Design & Construction.

Project Implementation Team

The Project Implementation Team will act as the key stakeholders to optimize project results by driving innovation, removing waste, and increasing value within the project's delivery. The Project Implementation Team shall consist of all stakeholders and influencers ensuring the aligned success of the project. The Owner's primary field voice shall come from the Construction Project Manager assigned to the Project by Medxcel Planning, Design & Construction.

- **1. Lead Superintendent:** On-site throughout construction; Daily reporting; Ensure project timeline; Ensure adherence to plans and specifications.
- **2. QA/QC/Cx:** On-site throughout construction; Regular reporting; Pre- and Post-Installation documentation; Review submittals, shop drawings, etc, Ensure adherence to plans and specifications; Coordinate commissioning, training and close-out.
- 3. **Safety:** On-site throughout construction; Daily reporting; Ensure OSHA compliance; Coordinate and lead PCRA, ICRA and ILSM assessments and implementations; Track and log near-misses, accidents, injuries and negative air readings.

Selection Process

Medxcel Planning, Design & Construction will review the submitted proposals. Medxcel reserves the right to request additional information from those submitting responses. The following criteria will be considered in the evaluation of the A3 documents submitted with the responses:

- 1. Responses to the A3 submissions as they clearly answer, illustrate, and relate to the qualifications and attributes outlined in this document.
- 2. The proposed qualifications and attributes of the personnel providing direct oversight and contact with Medxcel as members of the Design Team.
- 3. Understanding of project goals, general approach, and process to the project.

After Medxcel completes reviewing the submittals, the final firms may be chosen to present and interview with Ascension Saint Thomas Midtown.

Should an interview take place, no more than five key personnel shall be present at the interview. Business Development roles are restricted from participating in the interview process. An interview format will be issued with a notice of advancement. At its sole discretion, the Owner may ask written questions of Offerors, seek written clarifications, and conduct discussions with Offerors on the Proposal.

Terms and conditions, fees, prices, etc., shall follow the Ascension IPD Agreement and the Attachment Flowdown Terms. If a mutually acceptable agreement cannot be executed with the top-ranked firm, the owner may terminate discussions and initiate discussions with the next-ranked firm.
